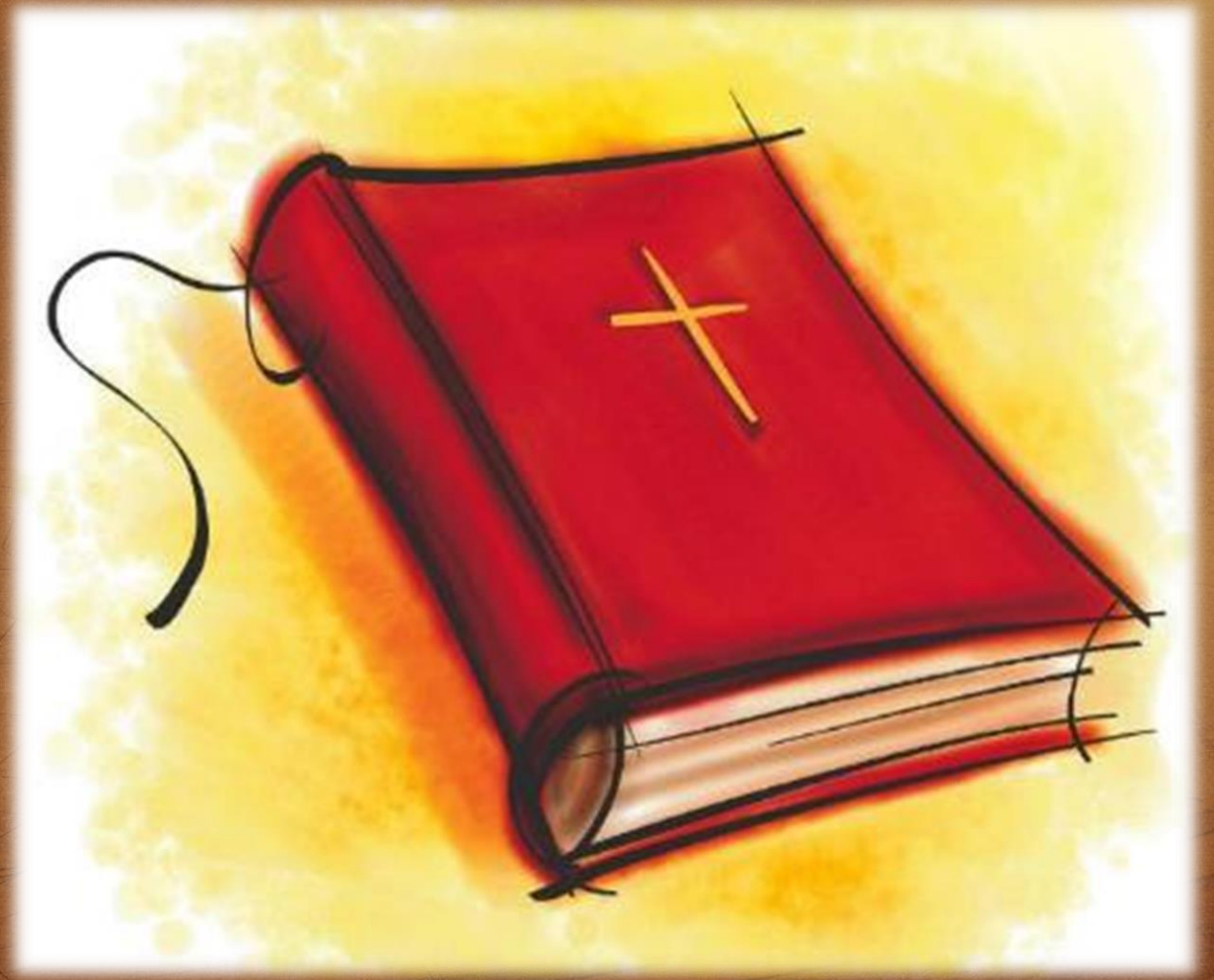

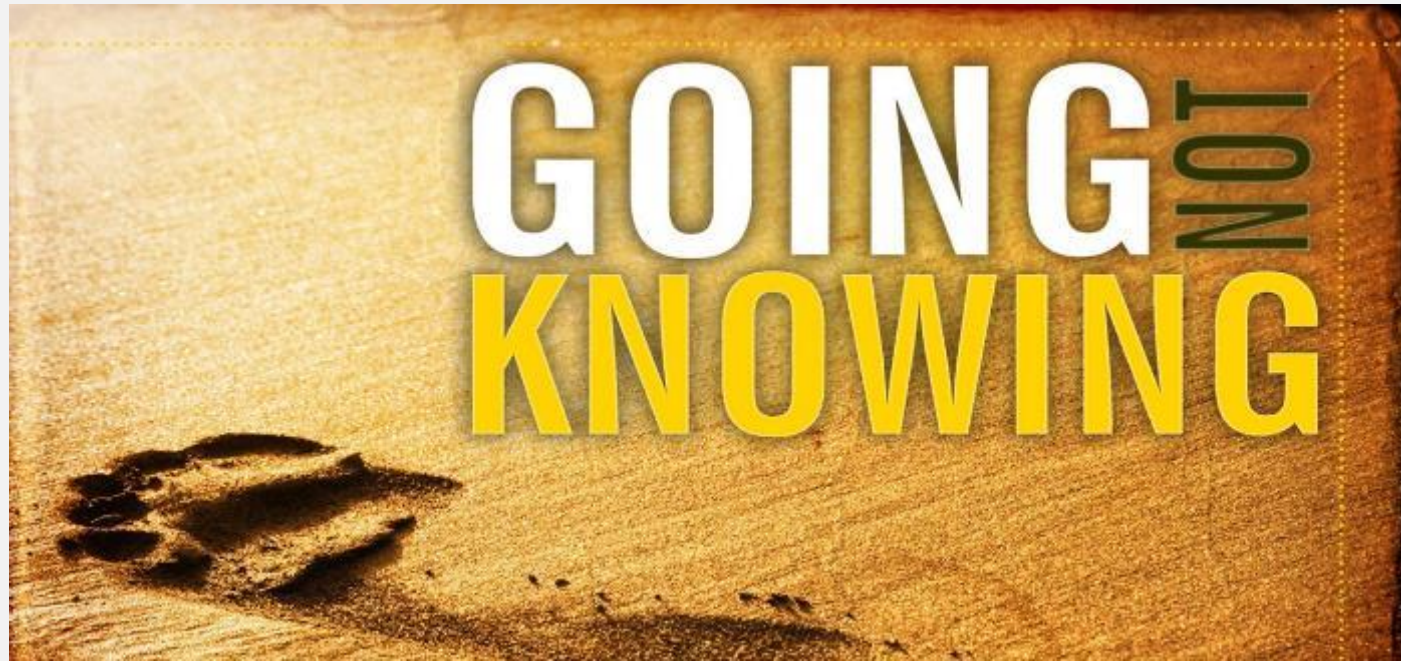

He had a son at the age of 100 – Hebrews 11:11-12

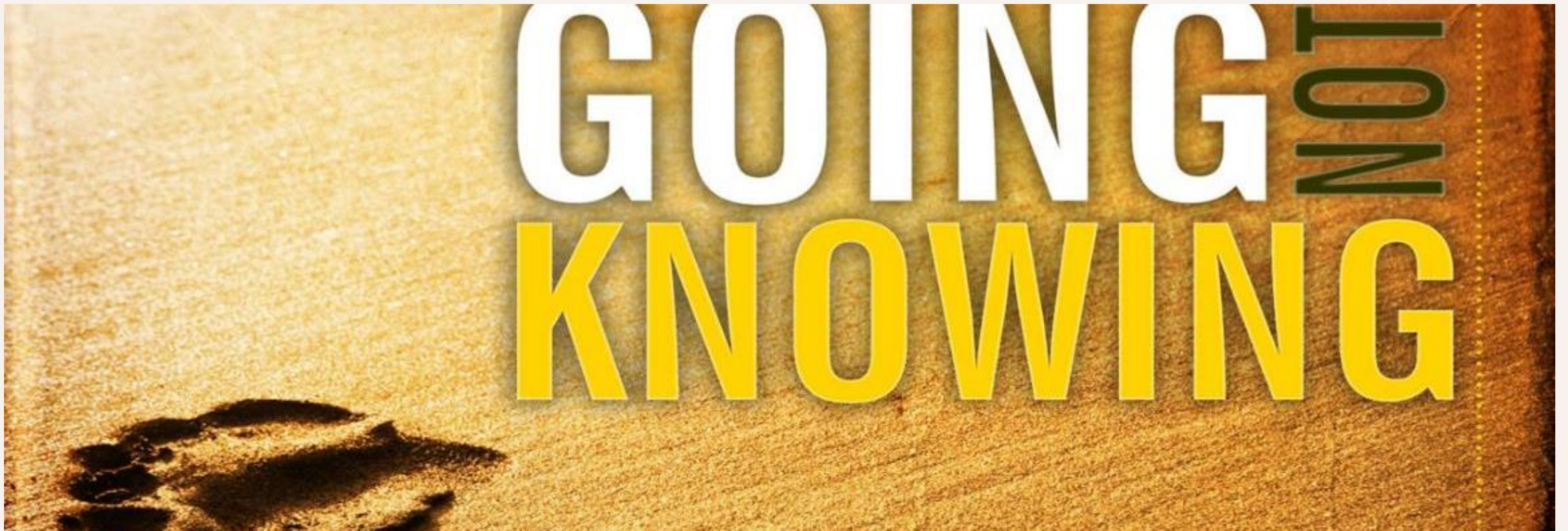
He offered his son as a sacrifice – Hebrews 11:17-19
