
#### FOCUS TEXT Luke 4:24-27

2 Kings 9 - 10

Assassinates Joram, Ahaziah. Kills Jezebel, sons of Ahab, 42 brothers of Ahaziah, all those loyal to Ahab, Baal worshippers

Naaman was healed of leprosy


